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Appendix A: Survey Questions

This appendix includes the survey questions presented to a random sample of students at three CSU campuses. The survey was administered electronically using Qualtrics survey software. Items were unnumbered on the survey. The formatting and appearance of the questions and response choices may differ from what is shown below, however, the wording is accurate unless otherwise specified. For prompts with multiple response choices (e.g., Question 8), the order of the individual items was randomized across respondents.
